SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Ministry reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, and
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation or to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) the Quotation Letter in Section II
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.
- (e) All pages must be initialled, every blank space (provided) must be completed and use of correction fluid is strictly prohibited

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may not be retyped for completion.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

5. Delivery

6. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Ministry, with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

7. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at *The Ministry of Health and Social Services – Finance and Procurement building, Procurement Management Unit (Tender Office), Harvey Street, Windhoek West, not later than Tuesday, 30 June 2020, Time: 11H00.*

8. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Ministry immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 7 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, will be posted on the website of the Ministry and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

9. Evaluation Criteria

The following criteria will be used for the evaluation of this bid. Violation or non-compliance of any of these criteria may lead to disqualification.

9.1 Ministerial Procurement Management Unit (PMU)/ Central Procurement Board (CPB)

- Bidders will be evaluated on compliance with the obligatory requirements and regulations as stipulated by the Central Procurement Board:
- Completion of the entire bid document
- Signing / initializing of entire bid document
- Principal Business of the bidding company
- Obligatory documents attached

9.2 Bid Conditions

- Bidders will be evaluated on compliance with and acceptance of the Procurement/Bid Conditions as provided in the bid invitation
- Completion of procurement/bid conditions
- Delivery, Installation and Training information

- Provision of after sales services and support (i.e. availability and proof of trained, skilled technical, competent technical staff) Bidders to attach proof of technical expertise in the form of training certificates. Bidders who fail to provide the above will be automatically be disqualified.
- Compliance with safety and quality standards and norms (certificates provided)
- Technical data sheet (brochure in full colour) attached
- Delivery period to be one of the major deciding factors

9.3 Service, Maintenance and Repair Conditions

- Bidders will be evaluated on compliance with and acceptance of the Service, Maintenance and Repair as provided in the bid invitation

9.4 Technical Specifications

- Completion of the original bid specifications
- Bidders must reply to ALL specifications and information requested ON the original document (including information regarding manufacturer, make/model and country of manufacturer). Any additional information can be attached to the specifications, clearly stating the corresponding number on the ministerial technical specifications. Retyped documents will not be accepted or evaluated.
- Bidders must reply to each specification individually and clearly. NO blank spaces, ditto (") marks, brackets (}), crosses (x) or checkmarks or abbreviation (y/n) will be accepted. Such responses will be deemed "invalid".
- All replies must be clear and legible
- All information requested (manufacturer, model, country of manufacture, price, etc.) must be provided so that the Ministerial Procurement Management Unit (PMU) or Ministerial Evaluating Committee can connect the quotation/cost breakdown and the brochure to the offered specifications.
- The colour brochures (technical data sheet) submitted must verify the supplier's specifications. No internet printouts and self-produced brochures will be accepted.

- Letter of authorizations and commitment from the manufacturer

10. Prices and Currency of Payment

*Prices shall remain fixed for the duration of the period and quoted in Namibian Dollars. The Ministry **shall not** consider price increases due to exchange rates, therefore bidders are advised to make their own projections.*

11. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to supply the goods/items and related services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: General Conditions of Contract and Contract Agreement.

12. Notification of Award and Debriefing

The Public Entity shall after award of contract promptly inform all unsuccessful bidders in writing of the name and address of the successful bidder and the contract amount and post a notice of award on its website within seven days. Furthermore, the Ministry shall attend to all requests for debriefing made in writing within 7 days of the unsuccessful bidders being informed of the award.
