Good morning Namibia

1. Good morning Moderator and good morning the people of Namibia. Allow me to regular update on Covid-19 in Namibia. We do not have a new case of Covid-19 positive in Namibia. Our Case No 22 is still in ICU on a ventilator but in a stable condition. There is no new development in his condition since my last briefing.
2. The status of Covid-19 in Namibian is as follow:
 - Confirmed Cases: 25
 - Recoveries: 16
 - Active Cases: 9
 - Deaths: 0
 - Total number tested: 4 108
 - Total tested yesterday 103
 - Results of yesterday Negative
 - Total contacts: 434
 - Total quarantine: 2 228
 - Total number discharged: 1 572
 - Total in quarantine: 656
3. We are now in Week 1 of Stage 3 of the State of Emergency. There are less restrictions now than in Stage 2. However, there is now more demand on the citizenry to conduct itself more responsibly in order not to erode the gains we have made.
4. I now invite the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of International Relations and Cooperation, Comrade Netumbo Nandi-Ndaitwah to introduce the keynote Speaker.
