CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO PURSUE TRAINING PROGRAMMES IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL WELFARE RELATED FIELDS, 2017 ACADEMIC YEAR: SADC REGION

APPLICATIONS ARE INVITED FOR THE FOLLOWING UNDERGRADUATE FIELDS:

- Bachelor of Science in Physiotherapy
- Bachelor of Science in Speech and Language Pathology
- Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy
- Bachelor of Science in Audiology
- Bachelor of Science in Dietetics
- Bachelor of Clinical Technology
- Bachelor of Biomedical Technology
- Bachelor Medical Orthotics and Prosthetic
- Bachelor of Science in Prosthetics and Orthotics
- Diploma Course in Orthopedic Technology

APPLICANTS MUST BE:

- Namibian citizens, Between the age of 18-30, In a good physical and mental health state, Must not be employed by the Ministry of Health and Social Services, Must not have received a study loan/grant from the Namibia Students Financial Assistance Fund (NSFAF) or any other sponsoring agency.
- **STUDENTS SELECTED FOR THE CUBAN SCHOLARSHIP SHOULD NOT APPLY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP.**

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE VARIOUS COURSES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

a) Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Audiology, Dietetics, Biomedical Technology, Speech and Language Pathology, Medical Orthotics and Prosthetic, and Clinical Technology

- **Requirements:** Grade 12 certificate (HIGCSE) with a minimum score of English 3, Mathematic 3, Physical Science 3 and Biology 3 or better symbol.
- Applicants with Bachelor of Science degree will also be considered.

b) Bachelor of Science in Prosthetics and Orthotics

- **Requirements:** Grade 12 Certificate with minimum 40 points in six subjects including, English C, Biology C, Mathematics C and Physical Science C or better symbols.

c) Diploma Course in Orthopedic Technology

Requirements: Grade 12 Certificate with minimum 35 points in six subjects including, English C, Biology C, Mathematics C and Physical Science C or better symbols.

The training period for the fields indicated above is 3- 4 years. The Government of the Republic of Namibia (MoHSS) will provide a full scholarship to the selected students.

THE SCHOLARSHIP WILL COVER THE FOLLOWING COSTS:

Registration and Tuition Fees, Accommodation, Books, Medical Insurance, Monthly Living Allowance and One Return Ticket

Application forms can be collected at the offices of the Regional Health Directors countrywide, and at office No. 2E 16, 2nd floor, Directorate Policy, Planning and Human Resource Development, Ministerial Building, Windhoek.

Completed applications forms must be submitted to the offices of Regional Health Directors in each Region, and at Office No. 2E 16, 2nd floor, Directorate Policy, Planning and Human Resource Development, Ministry of Health and Social Services Head office, Windhoek.

Applications must be accompanied by curriculum vitae, certified copies of educational qualifications, identification documents, and copy of a valid passport. Please note that only certification done by the Namibian Police will be accepted.
