The Ministry of Health and Social Services has been alerted by the Namibian High Commission in the Republic of Zambia that, two (2) Universities in Zambia have been banned from continuing to offer courses that ninety-one (91) Namibian students are enrolled in.

The Acting Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Health and Social Services will lead a delegation to Zambia next week; which will comprise of representatives from the Health Professions Councils of Namibia and the University of Namibia's School of Medicine; to assess the situation and take appropriate action.

The Ministry would like to assure the parents and the public at large, that the Ministry will not allow this adverse situation to negatively impact the performance of the students and the human resources development programme of the Ministry.

The public will be informed of the outcome of the mission.
