1. We are reporting a record number of ninety-six (96) new Covid-19 positive , consisting of ninety-five Namibians and one South African. Two are from Karasburg and two from Keetmanshoop, and from Windhoek. The remainder 91 cases are from Walvis Bay. Fifty-one are males and forty-five are female. The youngest case is 4 years and the oldest one is 56 years. They are all in stable condition. The normal protocol is being applied.
2. We have registered two new recoveries. Case 33 and 186 have recovered and discharged.
3. A total of 884 results were received from NIP and Pathcare jointly. Two known cases recorded a second negative, therefore have recovered.
