1. Good Morning Fellow Namibians! We have four new cases. All of them are imported cases.
2. **Case No 73**
Case No 73 is a 46-years old female of Indian nationality who travelled to Namibia on 17 June 2020 and got quarantined in Windhoek. As per our protocol she was tested for COVID-19. She did not have signs and symptoms consistent with Covid-19. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.
3. **Case No 74**
Case No 74 is a 30-years old female of Indian nationality who travelled to Namibia on 19 on the 17th June 2020. She was placed in quarantine in Windhoek. She was tested for Covid-19 as per our protocol. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.
4. **Case No 75**
Case No 75 is a 19-years old female of Indian nationality who travelled to Namibia on the 17th June 2020. She was placed in quarantine in Windhoek. She did not have Covid-19 related signs and symptoms at the time she was tested. The result came out positive. She is in a satisfactory condition.
5. **Case No 76**
Case No 76 is a 21-years old Namibian male who travelled from South Africa on the 29th May 2020. He was placed in quarantine in Windhoek. He is a contact to cases 27, 28 and 29. He had COVID-19 related symptoms which did resolve. The initial swabbing which was done on the 30th May 2020 came out negative. He was re-swabbed on the 21st June 2020. The result came out positive on the 23 June 2020. He is in a satisfactory condition.
6. The status of Covid-19 in Namibian is as following:
 - Confirmed Cases: 76
 - Recoveries: 21
 - Active Cases: 55
 - Deaths: 0
 - Total samples tested 7 740
 - Total tested yesterday: 187
 - Results: 4 positives
 - Active contacts: 318
 - Total quarantined: 3 450
 - Total discharged: 2 766
 - Total in quarantine: 684

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
